School Shootings – A Tragic Result of Teaching Evolution

April 20, 1999, two young men entered a high school in Littleton, Colorado, and opened fire. In a few hours the event was over, leaving 13 dead and more wounded. The gunmen also took their own lives.

The shooting at Columbine did for the subject of school shootings the same thing 9/11 would do two years later for terrorism – it brought it drastically and painfully to center stage.

Columbine remained the deadliest school shooting in US history until the Virginia Tech massacre in Blacksburg, Virginia. However, Columbine is still the deadliest school shooting at a public school.

The question after Columbine was simple – could this have been prevented? The answer was simple – yes! What caused Columbine in the first place? Let's look at what Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold did before the shooting.

Doom. A popular computer game, and one that Eric, the leader of the duo, played. Was this to blame? No. When it comes to video games, the problem is this – did the video game cause the violent inclinations or did the violent inclinations lead to them selecting that video game? Often it is the latter, as only one person out of thousands who have played such a game would do such. But nearly every analysis of the event came to conclude this was a factor.

The real factor was the teaching of evolution. Before the shooting, the duo made a videotape on which they mocked Jesus Christ and Rachel Scott, a Christian from their high school. Rachel was the first one killed at Columbine. They also said that a football player at school didn't deserve the jaw evolution had given him. During the shooting, Eric Harris wore a shirt that said "natural selection". I think it is painfully obvious what caused this, but the media would never come to the conclusion that should be obvious to anyone – the Columbine shooting was a direct result of the teaching of evolution.

From the Shooter's Own Mouths

The following are quotations from the basement tapes, 5 tapes that were found in the basement of one of the shooter's homes. These tapes were made by the two Columbine shooters, Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold, and they even state that the reason for making these tapes is to explain to people after the Columbine event what exactly happened and why they did what they did. These quotes contain swearing which has not been changed or removed. It is important that you read what the shooters themselves said before the attack of why they did it.

Quotation 1 – Evidence item #265 (8mm tape)

March 15, 1999

Dylan: “I know we're gonna have followers because we're so fucking God-like. We're not exactly human -- we have human bodies but we've evolved into one step above you, fucking human shit. We actually have fucking self-awareness.”

Quotation 2 – Evidence item #265 (8mm tape)

March 15, 1999

Dylan: “I don't like you, Rachel and Jen, you're stuck up little bitches, you're fucking little.. Christian, Godly little whores!”

Eric: “Yeah.. 'I love Jesus! I love Jesus!' -- shut the fuck up!”

Dylan: “What would Jesus do? What the fuck would I do..?” (he acts like he's shooting the camera with his hand, with sound to accompany it)

Eric: “I would shoot you in the motherfucking head! Go Romans! Thank God they crucified that asshole.”

Eric and Dylan: “Go Romans!” “Go Romans!!” “Yeah!!” “Wooo!”

Quotation 3 – Evidence item #298 (two 8mm tapes, one labeled “Reb’s Tape”)

Eric films his planning book, calling it the “Writings of God”.

It is clear that the observations have been wrong. It is clear that Rachel Scott was targeted at Columbine. It is clear that Eric and Dylan believed themselves to be gods, and that they way in which they attained this godhood was via evolution and natural selection. If there remains any doubt in your head as to the role evolution played in this event, there is no proof which will change your mind.
